Definitions

Crowdfund or Crowdfunding means the crowdfunding process contemplated by the Whitepaper by which the Polymerium Ltd. will receive financing for the development of the motor oils, petrochemicals, and the development of anti-counterfeiting protection for blockchain technology.

Crowdfunder means you and the legal or natural person participating in the Crowdfunding.

1. General

1.1 POLYMERIUM blockchain option is a cryptographic token, issued by Polymerium Ltd (plmico.com), and published in Wavesplatform (Waves) public blockchain.

1.5 POLYMERIUM is not an investment advisor and shall not be understood and interpreted as such. POLYMERIUM is not a security.

1.6 POLYMERIUM is/are not cryptocurrency, regardless of what legal meaning word "cryptocurrency" has, unless and to the extent the meaning of POLYMERIUM tokens are described and defined by these terms and conditions.

2. Acquisition of POLYMERIUM tokens

2.1 You agree to purchase and we agree to sell, on the terms set forth herein, POLYMERIUM tokens. We can provide a refund of the purchase price according our terms and conditions.

2.2 Tokens will be created and provided to Crowdfunders after completion of the Crowdfunding.

2.3 Tokens distributed in recognition of financing received by Polymerium Ltd during the Crowdfunding will constitute 100% of the total number of Tokens generated.

2.4 The price of the POLYMERIUM token is nominated in US dollars (USD)

2.5 The cost of the POLYMERIUM tokens will increase during Crowdfunding campaign.

2.5.1 On day 1 of the Crowdfunding, 1 POLYMERIUM token will be provided for the equivalent of 1 USD.

2.5.2 On days 2 to 30 (inclusive) of the Crowdfunding, the price of 1 POLYMERIUM token will increase according to a schedule that published on the website plmico.com.

2.6 After the end of Crowdfunding, it would be possible to submit a request for purchase of the POLYMERIUM tokens. However, we cannot guarantee that these requests would be fulfilled.

3. POLYMERIUM buyback

3.1 Buyback is the process of buying POLYMERIUM from Crowdfunders on crypto exchanges or directly from the plmico.com website according to the “public offer” that published on the website plmico.com.

3.2 Plmico.com estimates that approximately after 1 months, after production of motor oil, not less than 70% of the profit would be used to buyback POLYMERIUM from the market at the current market price but limited to 2 USD for 1 POLYMERIUM

3.3 Buyback would be carried out by Polymerium Ltd.

4. Exchange POLYMERIUM to motor oil.

4.1 Crowdfunders can exchange the POLYMERIUM to a motor oil.

4.2 The minimum exchange amount is 1000 POLYMERIUM

4.4 The exchange POLYMERIUM to the motor oil can be done after 1 year from the beginning of production. All product supplies are subject to additional agreement with producer and availability of the product.

5. Intellectual Property

5.1 We retain all right, title and interest in all of our intellectual property, including inventions, discoveries, processes, marks, methods, compositions, formulae, techniques, information and data, whether or not patentable, copyrightable or protectable in trademark, and any trademarks, copyrights or patents based thereon. You may not use any of our intellectual property for any reason, except with our express, prior, written consent.

5.2 In particular, we retain all intellectual property rights, mostly, but not limited, to copyright, over the source code forming POLYMERIUM tokens. This terms shall not be understood and interpreted in a way that they would mean assignment of intellectual property rights, unless it is explicitly defined so in this terms.

5.3 You are being granted a non-exclusive, non-transferable, revocable license to access and use the website and to use the POLYMERIUM tokens strictly in accordance with these Terms. As a condition of your use of the website and POLYMERIUM tokens you warrant to plmico.com that you will not use the website and POLYMERIUM tokens for any purpose that is unlawful or prohibited by these Terms. You may not use the POLYMERIUM tokens in any manner

that could damage, disable, overburden, or impair the website Site or interfere with any other party's use and enjoyment of the website, POLYMERIUM tokens or any other products offered thereto. You may not obtain or attempt to obtain any materials or information through any means not intentionally made available or provided for through the website and/or POLYMERIUM tokens and/or other services provided thereto. Limitation to the transferability of license shall not be understood in a way, that the users are not allowed to transfer POLYMERIUM tokens to third parties.

5.4 All content included on the website, including the POLYMERIUM tokens, and associated products and services, such as, but not limited to, text, graphics, logos, images, source code, as well as the compilation thereof, and any software used on the website is the property of Polymerium Ltd. and protected by copyright, trademark and other laws that protect intellectual property and proprietary rights. You agree to observe and abide by all copyright and other proprietary notices, legends or other restrictions contained in any such content and will not make any changes thereto.

6. Security

6.1 You will implement reasonable and appropriate measures designed to secure access to (i) any device associated with the email address associated with your account, (ii) private keys required to access any relevant Waves address, and (iii) your username, password and any other login or identifying credentials.

6.2 In case you suspect a security breach in any of the above mentioned, you will inform us immediately so we can take all required and possible measures to secure your account, POLYMERIUM and systems as whole.

6.3 In the event that you are no longer in possession of any device associated with your account or are not able to provide your login or identifying credentials, we may, in our sole discretion, and only if we are able, grant access to your account to any party providing additional credentials to us. We explicitly reserve the right to determine the additional credentials required, which may include, without limitation, a sworn, notarized statement of identity.

7. Privacy

7.1 As a principle, Plmico.com collects only what we need and will not share your personal information with any third parties other than our identity verification partner. Even within Plmico.com, access to your personal information is limited to a subset of employees who work on compliance and identity verification matters. Plmico.com is the only data controller and processor.

7.2 You will provide to us, immediately upon our notice of request, information that we, in our sole discretion, deem to be required to maintain compliance with any federal, state or local law, regulation or policy. Such documents include, but are not limited to, passports, driver's licenses, utility bills, photographs of you, government identification cards, or sworn statements.

7.3 Plmico.com reserves its right to request documentation, described in paragraph 7.1, prior to activating your account at any of plmico.com services, and any services, available through website. Plmico.com may refuse you access to Plmico.com services and website should it have doubts as to validity, authenticity and genuineness of the documents, provided by you.

7.4 Plmico.com collects information from running the website and products, provided thereto, and uses information, provided to us by you. When you visit the website or use our products, we collect information sent to us by your computer, mobile phone, or other access device. This information may include your IP address, device information including, but not limited to, identifier, name, and type, operating system, mobile network information and standard web log information, such as your browser type, and the pages you accessed on our website. When you use a location-enabled device with our website and products, we may collect geographical location data or use various means to determine the location, such as sensor data from your device that may, for instance, provide data on nearby cell towers and wi-fi access spots. However, we will not release your personally-identifying information to any third party without your consent, except as set forth herein.

7.5 If you create an account at our website and use our products, POLYMERIUM tokens included, we may collect and store the following types of information: Contact information - your name, address, phone, email and other similar information. Before permitting you to use our website and products, we may require you to provide

additional information (such as a date of birth, passport number, numbers that you may use or have registered with your local tax authority, or other data which can be used for personal identification purposes and that may be required to comply with applicable laws) so that we can verify your identity or address. We may also obtain information about you from third parties such as identity verification services.

7.6 When you use our website, we collect information about your transactions (such as date, time and amount of transaction) and your other activities on our website and we may collect information about your computer or other access device for fraud prevention purposes. We may collect additional information about you through your interactions with our support team.

7.7 When you access the website or use our products or services we (or Google Analytics on our behalf) may place small data files called cookies on your computer or other device. We use these technologies to recognize you as our user; customize our website and advertising; measure promotional effectiveness and collect information about your computer or other access device to mitigate risk, help prevent fraud, and promote trust and safety.

7.8 Throughout this policy, we use the term “personal information” to describe information that can be associated with a specific person and can be used to identify that person. We do not consider personal information to include information that has been anonymized so that it does not identify a specific user.

7.9 We protect your information using physical, technical, and administrative security measures to reduce the risks of loss, misuse, unauthorized access, disclosure, and alteration. Some of the safeguards we use are firewalls and data encryption, physical access controls to our data centers, and information access authorization controls. We also authorize access to personal information only for those employees who require it to fulfil their job responsibilities. All of our physical, electronic, and procedural safeguards are designed to comply with applicable laws and regulations.

7.10 We are sometimes required to compare the personal information you provide to third party databases in order to verify its accuracy and confirm your identity. This allows us to comply with state and federal anti-money laundering and “know your customer”

regulations. We will not sell or rent your personal information to third parties. We may combine your information with information we collect from other companies and use it to improve and personalize the website and our products, as well as our content and advertising. We may use your name and email address to provide you with information about products or services that may be of interest to you, but we will not use your personal information without complying with applicable laws and, where appropriate, obtaining your consent.

7.11 We reserve our right to share your personal information with:

(a) our banking partners (if you link a bank account, debit card, or credit card to your account);

(b) companies that we plan to merge with or be acquired by (should such a combination occur, we will require that the newly combined entity follow these terms with respect to your personal information, and you would as well receive prior notice of any change in applicable policy);

(c) 3rd party identification services providers for fraud prevention purposes;

(d) law enforcement, government officials, or other third parties when i) we are compelled to do so by a subpoena, court order, or similar legal procedure; or ii) we believe in good faith that the disclosure of personal information is necessary to prevent physical harm or financial loss, to report suspected illegal activity or to investigate violations of our terms;

(e) other third parties only with your prior consent or direction to do so.

Plmico.com will not provide your personal information to any other Plmico.com users without your consent or direction.

7.12 You may access, review and edit your personal information at any time by logging in to the website using your credentials.

8. Taxes

8.1 All your factual and potential tax obligations are your concern and Plmico.com is not in any case and under no conditions bound to compensate for your tax obligation or give you any advice related to tax issues, including but not limited what kind of filing or

reporting you need to do with the competent tax authority, which taxes and to which extent you are obliged to pay, which tax exemptions you are eligible to etc.

8.2 All fees and charges payable by you are exclusive of any taxes, and shall certain taxes be applicable, they shall be added on top of the payable amounts. Upon our request, you will provide us any information we reasonably request to determine whether we are obligated to collect VAT from you, including your VAT identification number. If any deduction or withholding is required by law, you will notify us and will pay us any additional amounts necessary to ensure that the net amount that we receive, after any deduction and withholding, equals the amount we would have received if no deduction or withholding had been required. Additionally, you will provide us with documentation showing that the withheld and deducted amounts have been paid to the relevant taxing authority.

9. Access to services

9.1 Plmico.com reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to terminate your access to the website and its related services or any portion thereof at any time, without notice, in particular due to legal grounds originating in anti-money laundering and know your client regulation and procedures.

10. Users from the United States

10.1 The website and its products are not offered for use to the citizens of the United States of America ("USA") regardless of their location, and are not offered to natural or legal persons, having their seat or habitual residence in the USA.

10.2 All activities of the website and its products are executed out of the USA.

10.3 By participating in the Crowdfunding, making payments, or receiving and holding POLYMERIUM Tokens you represent and warrant that you are not a US resident or citizen.

10.4 Due to the Plmico.com products being offered on the Internet (meaning both the world wide web and the Waves blockchain) Plmico.com understands that there is a possibility that there might be a certain "flow back" of Plmico.com products into the USA or to the citizens of the USA. Plmico.com consequently explicitly prohibits persons from paragraph 10.1 from using Plmico.com products

and website. Plmico.com shall not be held liable for any legal or monetary consequence arising of such use. Such persons using Plmico.com products and website despite the prohibition shall on first request indemnify and hold harmless Plmico.com from any legal or monetary consequence arising of their breach of this terms as described in this paragraph.

11. Notices

11.1 We may provide any notice to you under this Agreement by: (i) posting a notice on the website; or (ii) sending an email to the email address then associated with your account. Notices we provide by posting on the website will be effective upon posting and notices we provide by email will be effective when we send the email. It is your responsibility to keep your email address current. You will be deemed to have received any email sent to the email address then associated with your account when we send the email, whether or not you actually receive or read the email.

11.2 To give us notice under this Agreement, you must contact us by email to info@plmico.com. We may update this email address for notices to us by posting a notice on our website. Notices to us will be effective one business day after they are sent.

11.3 All communications and notices to be made or given pursuant to this Agreement must be in the English language.

12. Risks

12.1 You understand that POLYMERIUM token, blockchain technology, the Waves protocol, Waves and other associated and related technologies are new and untested and outside of Plmico.com control and adverse changes in market forces or the technology, broadly construed, may affect POLYMERIUM' s performance under this agreement.

12.2 In addition to the above, you also acknowledge that you have been warned of the following risks, associated with the website and products offered thereto and in particular with POLYMERIUM token.

(a) Legal risks regarding securities regulations

There is a risk that in some jurisdictions POLYMERIUM might be considered to be a security, or that it might be considered to be a security in the future. Plmico.com has avoided making POLYMERIUM tokens available to natural and legal persons from such

jurisdictions, however Plmico.com does not give warranties or guarantees that POLYMERIUM token is not a security also in all jurisdictions, where it was made available. Each user of POLYMERIUM tokens shall bear its own legal or financial consequences of POLYMERIUM being considered a security in their respective jurisdiction.

Acquiring cryptographic tokens in possession and exchanging them for other cryptographic tokens will most likely continue to be scrutinized by various regulatory bodies around the world, which has so far given mixed reactions and regulatory impact. The legal ability of Plmico.com to provide POLYMERIUM tokens could in some jurisdictions be eliminated by future regulation or legal actions. In the event, it turns out with a high degree certainty that POLYMERIUM tokens are not legal in certain jurisdiction, Plmico.com will either a) cease operations in that jurisdiction, or b) adjust POLYMERIUM tokens in a way to comply with the regulation should that be possible and viable.

(b) Risks associated with the Waves protocol

POLYMERIUM token is based upon the Waves protocol. As such, any malfunction, unintended function or unexpected functioning of the Waves protocol may cause the POLYMERIUM token to malfunction or function in an unexpected or unintended manner. Waves, the native unit of account of the Waves Protocol may itself lose value in ways similar to POLYMERIUM token, and also other ways. (c) Risks associated with users' credentials

Any third party that gains access to the user's login credentials for the website or private keys may be able to dispose of the user's POLYMERIUM tokens. To minimize this risk, the purchaser should guard against unauthorized access to their electronic devices.

(d) Risk of unfavorable regulatory action in one or more jurisdictions

Blockchain technologies have been the subject of scrutiny by various regulatory bodies around the world. The functioning of the Waves network and associated blockchain networks and POLYMERIUM could be

impacted by one or more regulatory inquiries or actions, including but not limited to restrictions on the use or possession of digital tokens like POLYMERIUM, which could impede or limit their existence, permissibility of their use and possession, and their value.

(e) Risk of theft and hacking

Hackers or other groups or organizations may attempt to interfere with your token wallet, the website or the availability of POLYMERIUM tokens in any number of ways, including without limitation denial of service attacks, Sybil attacks, spoofing, smurfing, malware attacks, or consensus-based attacks.

(f) Risk of security weaknesses in the POLYMERIUM source code or any associated software and/or infrastructure

There is a risk that the POLYMERIUM, or other third parties may unintentionally introduce weaknesses or bugs into the POLYMERIUM source code interfering with the use of or causing the loss of POLYMERIUM tokens.

(g) Risk of weaknesses or exploitable breakthroughs in the field of cryptography

Advances in cryptography, or technical advances such as the development of quantum computers, could present risks to cryptocurrencies and the Waves platform and POLYMERIUM, which could result in the theft or loss of tokens.

(h) Risk of low or no liquidity

Even though there are currently online services available, which enable possibility of exchange of cryptographic tokens between themselves, and also, some of them enable exchange of cryptographic tokens for fiat money, there are no warranties and/or guarantees given that POLYMERIUM tokens will be subject to exchange for other cryptographic tokens and/or fiat money, and no guarantees are given whatsoever with the capacity (volume) of such potential exchange. It shall be explicitly cautioned, that such exchange, if any, might be subject to poorly-understood regulatory oversight, and Plmico.com does not give any warranties in regard to any exchange services providers. Users might be exposed to fraud and failure

(i) Risk of uninsured losses

Unlike bank accounts or accounts at some other financial institutions, funds held using POLYMERIUM or Waves network are entirely uninsured.

(j) Risk of malfunction in the Waves network or any other blockchain

It is possible that the Waves network or any other network, to which POLYMERIUM is interacting with, malfunctions in an unfavorable way, including but not limited to one that results in the loss of POLYMERIUM.

14.3 We and our affiliates will not be liable for any delay or failure to perform any obligation under this Agreement where the delay or failure results from any cause beyond our reasonable control, including acts of God, labor disputes or other industrial disturbances, electrical, telecommunications, hardware, software or other utility failures, earthquake, storms or other elements of nature, blockages, embargoes, riots, acts or orders of government, acts of terrorism, or war, changes in blockchain technology (broadly construed), changes in the Waves or any other blockchain protocols or any other force outside of our control.
